Due to the large numbers, we will not be able to accept registration after Aug. 20th. Please plan accordingly. Consider boys moving into your area and possible changes to assure YOU do not keep someone from participating.

LEADERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

Each **den** (Wolf, Bear, Webelos) must have two deep leadership. Each **den** will have separate activities at day camp specific to their age level (you will not be together as a pack). Tiger Cubs need to have their Adult Partner with them. All leaders attending day camp are **required** to attend a brief training (about 15 minutes) at **Roundtable in September** to get oriented with the activities they will be doing with the boys at day camp. You will also need to have your *medical forms* and *tour permit* at this time. Leaders will receive the shirts for the pack at this time as well.

If you have a **large den**, it is suggested that you provide additional leadership (1 adult for every 3 or 4 boys). The reason for this is that leaders will need to be **actively engaged** in helping the boys complete their activities and tasks. Little boys often need hands on help from adults to get their projects accomplished.

No additional leadership is required unless you are in Snow Canyon district. Snow Canyon district is requiring two additional leaders to serve on staff from each pack. These leaders do *not* get registered with your pack for day camp. They need to contact Kim Payne at 628-0219, and will be required to attend a special training in August.
